Color Guard

As of July 1, 2019, the Color Guard uniform changed from regalia (which included a ceremonial cape and chapeau, a tuxedo, white gloves and a sword) to the new uniform (that consists of blue blazers with the fourth-degree emblem, dark gray slacks, blue tie and black beret). Currently our Assembly does not have a Color Guard with the new uniforms. There is a need for us to have a Color Guard for funerals, the Diocese of Charlotte's 50th Anniversary, and IHM's 75th Anniversary. The new uniform package costs \$449.00. Other accessories, if desired, (such as gloves, overcoat, shoes, and face mask) are extra. The new uniform can be purchased at www.kofcuniform.com. A motion was passed to subsidize purchase of the uniform package in the amount of \$200, for the first ten Knights to submit proof of purchase. The expectation is that they will be available for, and participate in our Assembly's Color Guard.
