### **Retention Report**

We have 127 members on our roster. Currently 102 are in good standing from a dues standpoint. There are 25 members not paid, 16 of which have not paid for two years or more. Two of the 16 have come back to Joe with address unknown. Joe has researched as best he could, but could not locate them. The lost dues from these unpaid members represents \$1,310.00 to the assembly.

#### **Cash Report**

In summary for the period March 27, 2022 – April 24, 2022, receipts \$0.16 and disbursements of \$68.47, resulting in a deficit of \$68.31, resulting in a cash balance of \$8,875.90. Outstanding items that have not yet cleared are (\$450.00). Balance after all items clear is \$8,425.90.
